**General Supplies – Non-Academic**

**Calculator (TI 84 graphing for Algebra I; TI 34 Multi-View calculator for math)-ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE THEIR OWN CALCULATOR.**

At Hunter Middle School, we use the **TI-34 Multiview** calculator starting in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. This calculator will be used in each of their math classes through the end of 8<sup>th</sup> grade math. An investment in a personal calculator will aid your child in class as well as with homework and TN Ready testing. These calculators can be difficult to find in stores in August due to high demand. We suggest you either order them online or through the school. Here at school we can purchase the **TI-34** at cost through a supplier for as little as **\$16.19**; however, the more we order the more that price will drop. The official price will be set based on the number ordered. We will send home an order form at the beginning of the school year. Money will be due **BEFORE** the order is made.
